

- This is a controlled facility. To gain entry, please present a valid student ID, Tobacco, food, glass bottles, cans, alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind Faculty/Staff ID, membership card, or day pass.
- Users are expected to read and adhere to all posted rules and instructions Use of bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, hover boards and drones are for each specific activity area.
- Parents, legal guardians, or a responsible person 16 and over must accompany youths under 14 years of age at all times. Anyone under the age of 14 is prohibited from using fitness and strength equipment.
- Consult a physician prior to engaging in physical activity. The GVSU Recreation Center is not responsible for accidents or injuries that occur due to the nature of the activity.
- Report injuries, accidents, or equipment failures immediately to recreation center staff.
- Appropriate athletic apparel including nonrevealing shirts, athletic shorts or pants, and closed toed/closed heel athletic shoes are required to be worn. See specifics <u>HERE</u> that apply for all area of the Recreation Center.
- For safety reasons, all personal belongings must be placed in storage cubbies or lockers.
- GVSU is not responsible for any personal belongings lost or stolen.
- Equipment is not to be removed from activity areas and must be used for its intended purpose.

- The on-duty supervisors have authority over all activity area conduct and may expel a user from the facility for failure to follow instructions.
