The following scholarships require:

- » Admission to GVSU by March 1 for spring/summer semesters, July 1 for fall semester, and November 1 for winter semester
- » Full-time enrollment status
- » Maintaining satisfactory academic progress

<b>PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP</b>	Up to \$1,200	Up to \$2,400	3.5+	✓	Must be a member of the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society at Michigan community colleges. Must be a graduate of an accredited community college in Michigan and have earned an associate degree. Must be admitted to GVSU as a new, full-time transfer student for fall enrollment. GVSU must be the first institution attended after the student has earned an associate degree. Offered for fall semester only. Grand Valley offers more than 500 additional scholarships available to admitted students. These scholarships vary and may be based on interests, academic performance, special talents, or major. Below is important information on the process for these scholarships.

- After you are admitted to GVSU, you will receive your network login credentials that can be used to log in to the myScholarships portal.
- It is recommended that you log in to myScholarships about 1 week after filing your FAFSA to review any additional opportunities you may qualify for.
- You can begin submitting scholarship applications in early November. The majority of scholarship deadlines fall between February 15 and March 1 but a few have different deadlines so it is recommended to apply as soon as possible.
- Scholarships are awarded March through June.
- You can apply for these scholarships each year.
