#### **Preparing for the Funding Search**

- Develop a project plan:
  - What is the project/programming idea?
  - What is the problem that will be addressed?
  - Who will benefit from the project?
  - What is the geographic area of the project?
  - How much funding is needed?
  - How long will it take to fully develop the project?
  - What resources are needed to make the idea a success staffing, student assistance, equipment, space, materials, etc.?
  - Who are possible collaborators- internal and external? (ForagerOne)
  - What are the key words to identify opportunities?

#### PIVOT-RP

We suggest you start with <u>Pivot-RP</u>. GVSU is pleased to offer Pivot-RP service to any faculty or staff with an @gvsu.edu e-mail address. The database offers a wide variety of federal, non-federal, and private funding opportunities for any discipline. When you create an account and profile in Pivot-RP, you can save search criteria, track and share opportunities, and receive weekly updates on new funding opportunities.

#### **FEDERAL TOOLS**

<u>Grants.gov</u> - Online source to **find and apply** for federal government grants. Today, Grants.gov is a central storehouse for information on over 1,000 grant programs and provides access to approximately \$400 billion in annual awards.

National Science Foundation (NSF) Funding Search – This site is specific to NSF funding opportunities and may be filtered by Directorate and Division or you can search by keywords.

National Institutes of Health (NIH) Grants & Funding – The NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts is a searchable database. You can sign up to receive weekly updates of new grant opportunities.

US Department of Education - This site is specific to federal education grants.

#### INTERNAL FUNDING SOURCES AND RESOURCES

<u>Center for Scholarly and Creative Excellence (CSCE) Funding Opportunities</u> – Several funding opportunities are offered to primarily faculty in areas such as Seed Funding for research, dissemination of work, and collaborative activity.

<u>Center for Undergraduate Scholar Engagement (CUSE)</u> – Check out the CUSE website for information on internal funding opportunities, external funding, and fellowships.

- <u>Lakers Venture Grant Program</u> provides students with up to \$2,000 in funding to conduct immersive, full-time, student-driven, original and independent research or to pursue experiential projects in the arts.
- <u>Academic Conference Fund</u> the ACF is available to all undergraduate students who may be looking for one time funding to present/perform at an academic conference related to their major, minor, and/or professional goals.
- Academic and Professional Enrichment Fund the APEF provides travel funds up to \$500 to support undergraduate student travel to academic conferences and meeting coordinated by a faculty sponsor.

#### Pivot-RP

<u>Pivot-RP</u> is the most comprehensive resource for finding funding opportunities. Coupled with a database of scholarly profiles, Pivot helps automate the process of matching financial support to researchers and partners. Pivot includes billions of dollars in funding opportunities from the broadest scope of sources, including U.S. and international governments, private foundations, non-profits, universities, commercial entities and more – all in one easy to search tool.

By creating a Pivot-RP account with your faculty/staff e-mail, you will have the ability to (1) identify new funding opportunities that match your research; (2) create and save customized searches; (3) save personalized lists of opportunities for future (Tracked); (4) share opportunities and create groups; and (5) receive e-mail reminders of upcoming submission deadlines.






#### **Pivot-RP**



- No login needed to complete a funding search!





# **Searching Awarded Grants**

- Reading awarded grants can help:
  - Identify:
    - who the sponsor is giving money to universities, religious organizations, K-12
    - the kinds/topics of projects a sponsor supports
    - collaborators and competitors
    - the geographical area and how much is given
  - Serve as an example of what a well-written proposal looks like
  - Uncover which sponsors are supporting projects in the project field
  - Identify publications that are coming out of the research

- Remember, if you put your keywords into PIVOT-RP, it will do a lot of the work for you.
- Nearly all federal programs will appear in grants.gov, but there is often more detailed information on the department or agency websites (e.g. NSF, NIH, DoED).
- Professional associations and higher ed associations also may offer funding opportunities.
- Sometimes just entering key words in a web search engine works, too!





# You found an opportunity! Now what?

- Read the funding announcement to understand the rules and limitations and share it with your grants and contract specialist.
- \*\*Talk with your chair/director/unit head and dean about the project and make plans to accommodate your research as part of your workload, etc.\*\*
- All sponsored programs must be routed through OSP, so contact us early in the process.
- We will assist you in creating a timeline and making a checklist of all the required documents for submission.
