## **How Do I Find My MAC Address/Physical Address and IP Address?**

### **Windows 8 & 10 Operating Systems**

Bring up the Windows Side bar (on the right side) and click on Settings icon at the bottom icon Settings.

At the top Click on Control Panel, when it opens, change the “View by:” in the upper left to large or small icons.

Double click on Networking and Sharing Center icon from the group

On the left side of the window, select “Change Adapter Settings”. Select either your Ethernet or wireless (if available) adapter as needed.

From there, right click on each to select Status, then click “Details” button to find your IP address, & MAC/Physical Address, and various other properties regarding your connection.

### **Windows 7 Operating System**

Click on the Start menu (circle with the flag with four colors on it) in the lower left hand corner of the screen.

Go to Control Panel, when it opens, change the “View by:” in the upper left to large or small icons.

Double click on Networking and Sharing Center icon from the right

On the left hand side in the blue shaded region, select “Change Adapter Settings”. Select either your Ethernet or wireless (if available) adapter.

From there, click “Details” to find your IP, subnet, and various other properties regarding your connection.

### **Mac OS X**

Open 'System Preferences' (from the Apple Menu or usually found in the Dock) and select Network.

Specify the interface on the list at the left.

For 'Built-in Ethernet', the IP address is on the right, then select the Advanced button. Use the Ethernet ID as your MAC or physical address.

For “WiFi”, the IP address is on the right, then select the Advanced button. Use the AirPort ID as your MAC or physical address.

**\*\*Make sure you remove the file sharing program from your computer or mobile device!! If a second infringement occurs, you will need to report to the Dean of Students.**

Once you have filled out the paperwork and deleted the file sharing program from your computer, bring the paperwork to 010 Mary Idema Pew Library (Allendale).
