Join Us: Workday @ GVSU Town Hall March 23

A Workday @ GVSU Town Hall for faculty and staff is coming soon, and we hope you can join us. This session is a chance to pause, reflect, and look ahead together as we continue to strengthen Workday as *one unified system* for our campus.

During the town hall, you'll:

- **Celebrate** key accomplishments since Workday went live two years ago
- **Hear** how feedback from across the institution is shaping platform optimization priorities
- **Get** an update on the Workday Student implementation - and what's coming next
- **Ask** questions, share insights, and connect directly with GVSU's Workday leaders

More details will be shared soon. We hope you'll join us for this important conversation and help shape what's next for Workday at GVSU.

As a critical step in moving GVSU's strategic priority of student success forward, funding for all 14 of the two-year advising positions has been secured through June 30, 2027. Within this, seven of the 14 positions will be moved to permanent base funding in the 2026-27 year making the positions a part of our regular operating budget moving forward. The other seven positions are funded through June 30, 2027 with the intention of moving them to the base budget in 2027-28, dependent upon available funding. Funding for the advising positions is being obtained through reallocation of funds from other areas of the institution. The decision by SLT to reallocate funds to advising is a result of the data showing that centers with new advisors increased student appointments, increased appointments by students of color and first-generation students, and increased student satisfaction with advising as shown on the National Survey of Student Engagement.


Protecting Your Energy
