Student Volunteers Needed for the Ottawa Gauntlet on October 15

WHAT: The Ottawa Gauntlet is a fun and lively competition among a group of Ottawa Hills High School students as they learn and practice professional skills. There are four rounds to the competition with students being evaluated and advancing to higher rounds based on their performance. Those who “run the gauntlet” and advance to the final round receive scholarships for college.

Round 2 of the gauntlet will be held at the L. William Seidman Center on Wednesday, October 15. Sign up to help make this a memorable and impactful experience for 20-30 Ottawa Hills high school students.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: Volunteers will be assigned as team leaders for a group of 4-6 high schoolers. Their role will be to welcome students to Seidman, encourage them, and help them move through the gauntlet by directing them and ensuring that they are clear on the objectives of each of seven stations that comprise the gauntlet. Virtual, synchronous event orientation will be provided prior to the event. Seidman student volunteers will earn Admiral points towards the Sustainability & Societal Impact Professional Readiness Competency. Five (5) volunteers are needed to serve as team leaders.

WHEN: Round 2 is Wednesday, October 15 from 8:30am-2:00pm with lunch provided. Volunteers must make a commitment to be there the whole time and will not be able to leave the event to attend class or make other commitments so please only sign up if you do not have class during this window of time.
