## Research in Progress

"Effects of COVID-19 on Study Abroad" (On-Going). (January 2022 - Present).

Covid-19 has severely disrupted student exchange. Comparing pre- with post-pandemic student mobility at public universities in Michigan (GVSU), Austria (Johannes Kepler University, Linz) and Germany (Pädagogische Hochschule Schwäbisch Gmünd), this comparative pilot study investigates the pandemic's effect on new modes and models of student exchange at the individual micro and institutional meso levels. It uses a mixed methods approach, consisting of the analysis of institutional student exchange data between 2019 and 2023 and interviews, surveys or focus groups with students, faculty, staff, administrators, and other stakeholders, like funding agencies and study abroad organizations.

The study asks questions, including how and to what degree was study abroad and international student exchange affected by the pandemic? What were the effects on broadening or reducing access for different demographic groups of students? What course-based teaching innovations happened in the realm of virtualization, such as online programs through study abroad providers and partner institutions, remote internships, project- and team-based collaborative online international learning (COIL)? Did universities expand online courses for students residing abroad? Did the virtualization also affect advising, college fairs, internships, and other forms of international student exchange? Will this trend continue because of the rise of travel restrictions, health liability, safety considerations, travel costs, and environmental concerns, as some recent surveys suggest (ACE Mapping Internationalization on U.S. Campuses 2022)?

"A Bridge Too Far? Transatlantic Relations at the Crossroads in the Views of U.S. and German Foreign Policy Experts" (On-Going). (September 2019 - December 2023).

"Squaring pegs in a round hole? A comparison of international students with study abroad and non-study abroad students at a U.S. Midwestern college" (On-Going). (January 2021 –

December 2023).

In recent decades, the number of U.S. students studying abroad and international students studying in U.S. higher education institutions has rapidly risen while the overall number of U.S. students is stagnating. Using multinomial logistic regressions, this sociological study analyses the similarities and differences in student characteristics of these three groups and how they converge or differ over time based on a large quantitative dataset from a four-year public liberal arts college in the U.S. Midwest between 2007 and 2017. Initial findings show that international and study abroad students differ from U.S. students not studying abroad by age, race/ethnicity, academic major, GPA, and merit-based scholarships whereas international students stand out from U.S. students by their non-first-generation status, non-membership in honors programs, participation in STEM programs, semester preference, and gender distribution. These outcomes help us to better understand long term trends of a diversifying student body, the sustainability of this process, and efforts to overcome disparities.
