I am just following up on the call for data that I mentioned last week. For my fellowship project, I am looking for data on 1) **bryophytes and lichens** (occurrence only, at species level, georeferenced and dated), ideally paired with 2) **microclimate data** (soil temperature and moisture at least over a whole year). The species data should have been recorded within a distance of 1-2 metres of the microclimate loggers and within a timeframe of a year of the microclimate being monitored. Species should be bipolar (i.e., present in the Arctic and Antarctica), but I can check this for you.
