After the bylaws updates, there are now 2 open spots on the LGBTQ+ FSA steering committee. Current openings are in programming/events and communication. Commitment is only a few hours a month and all steering committee members receive a small stipend for their work each semester. Commitment would be through May 2026, with possibility to continue on if elected in April.

#### Join the Advocacy Sub-Committee!

Interested in being more involved with 2SLGBTQIA+ advocacy on campus? Consider joining the advocacy sub-committee. This group meets throughout the semester and works on various advocacy projects and events. For the fall, they are focusing on building awareness about resources and for the winter they are focusing on professional development and training.






#### Pumpkin Spice & Poltergeist Curses & Cold Brew
