#### TOWN HALL REVIEW

## Thank you to everyone who attended the Town Hall Meeting and/or voted absentee!

We had a great turnout and appreciate your commitment to the health and longevity of our organization!

After a brief introduction of the Steering Committee and a preview of the remaining events for the semester, we started with a discussion of the options for an updated name for the organization. After voting on the name, we proceeded to talk through the proposed changes to the organization constitution and bylaws, voting on sections after they were discussed. The full results of the voting (both live and absentee) are presented below.

#### Organization Name Change Vote

#### Winner (13 votes) - LGBTQ+ Faculty Staff Association

8 votes - Queer Faculty Staff Association

1 vote - Pride Alliance Faculty Staff Association

2 votes - Rainbow Connection Faculty Staff Association (suggested at town hall meeting)

O votes - LGBT Faculty Staff Association (no change)

#### Join the Steering Committee!

After the bylaws updates, there are now 2 open spots on the LGBTQ+ FSA steering committee. Current openings are in programming/events and communication. Commitment is only a few hours a month and all steering committee members receive a small stipend for their work each semester. Commitment would be through May 2026, with possibility to continue on if elected in April.

#### Join the Advocacy Sub-Committee!

Interested in being more involved with 2SLGBTQIA+ advocacy on campus? Consider joining the advocacy sub-committee. This group meets throughout the semester and works on various advocacy projects and events. For the fall, they are focusing on building awareness about resources and for the winter they are focusing on professional development and training.


