



- Discuss expectations about priorities
   Academic, living, communication, socializing
- Let them do their own problem solving
   "Who might be able to help you with this?"
   "What do you think you might do?"
- Make it okay to ask for help and use resources
- Encourage exploring majors and careers
- Try not to put your anxiety and fears on your student
- Ask about what they are learning, not just about grades
- Encourage them to engage in and outside of classroom
- Frame struggles as part of the process
- Be confident that you have prepared them well and that everything will be ok!
