

<p>When and how will I know if my application has been certified?</p>	<p>You will receive an email once your application has been processed. You will also receive another one after you submit your invoice and that has been processed for payment.</p>
<p>Does the money go to the student or the school?</p>	<p>You will submit an application through your MINGSTAP dashboard. You will be asked to verify your mailing address because the check will be mailed to you at that address. Please make sure it is correct because checks cannot be forwarded.</p>
<p>Do I have to make payment arrangements with the school?</p>	<p>Yes, you will need to make payment arrangements with the school because we will not be sending funds until the semester is over.</p>
<p>Do I have to apply for FTA to be eligible for the MINGSTAP program?</p>	<p>If you are eligible to use FTA and don't apply or have a valid exemption you will not be authorized to receive funds from the MINGSTAP program.</p> <p>Below is the list of exemptions:</p> <div data-bbox="337 856 1572 1499" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 10px;"> <p>FTA Exceptions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Service members who use FTA for any portion of their undergrad degree and who are working towards their master's degree, but have not yet completed Advance Leadership Course (ALC), Warrant Officer Advanced Course (WOAC), or Career Captions Course (CCC).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Service members that are currently using Chapter 1606 GI Bill ,Chapter 1607 GI Bill.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Service members working for a degree higher than a Master's (Doctorate or Professional).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> PT/HT/WT information is not correct due to the lag time between SIBX and GoArmyEd.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Service member used the max 16 credits or \$4000 for the fiscal year.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Service members that are in a VA wok study program are not eligible for FTA.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> ROTC SMP cadets that are on any type of scholarship to include room and board are not eligible for FTA.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Airforce M-Day member who is not authorized FTA</li> </ul> </div>
<p>What are the new amounts?</p>	<p>Associates Degree = up to \$14400 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit          Bachelor's degree = up to \$14400 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit</p> <p>Training = up to \$6000 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit          Certification = up to \$6000 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit          Masters = up to \$6000 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit          Professional = up to \$6000 per academic year \$600 credit hour limit</p> <p>The school must also be eligible to receive FTA in order to qualify.</p>
<p>Do I have to apply every semester?</p>	<p>You will submit an application once a year and your invoices will be submitted after every semester/term.</p>
