To return to Grand Valley, you will need to:

- ☐ Gather unofficial transcripts from any institution you attended after leaving GVSU.
- ☐ Call your nearest location to schedule an appointment with an academic advisor.
- ☐ Call the Registrar's office at (616) 331-3327 to complete re-entry. This can be done during your advising appointment.
- ☐ File your FAFSA for financial aid consideration at fafsa.gov/.

After you have been readmitted:

- ☐ Familiarize yourself with any new policies and procedures with our virtual Welcome Back Guide.
- ☐ Register for classes using myBanner by visiting gvsu.edu and clicking the myBanner icon in the top right corner of the page.
- ☐ Apply for scholarships at gvsu.edu/scholarships/.
