



Masters of Education Scholarship Program Process

1) Verify Eligibility

Only individuals employed at GVSU authorized charter schools, in full-time positions requiring a teaching or administrator certificate, are eligible for the scholarship.

- Starting Fall 2019 Semester:
 - 50% tuition coverage for those with less than five years of employment
 - 80% tuition coverage for those with five or more years of employment at **current** GVSU authorized school

Scholarship funds are limited to twelve (12) credits per person, per academic year (Fall Semester through Spring/Summer Semester).

In order to receive scholarship funds, applicants must complete the Scholarship Program Application **before** each semester.

2) Choose Program or Course(s)

All graduate level courses offered by the GVSU College of Education are eligible for scholarship funds, including EDR 612 and EDR 613. Additionally, courses within the Professional Master of Arts in Social Innovation program, offered by the Integrative, Religious, and Intercultural Studies Department, are covered.

4) Complete Scholarship Program Application

- A G-Number is required to complete the application.
- Your log-in information is your GVSU email address and password.

If you meet the Eligibility Requirements, your scholarship funds will be applied to your GVSU Student Account within approximately four weeks of you submitting your application.

5) Pay Remaining Tuition and Fees

You are responsible for paying the tuition and fees not covered by your scholarship funds.

6) Successfully Complete Course(s)

If you drop or fail a course after receiving scholarship funds, your student account will be billed for the amount awarded, and you will be responsible for paying the balance.
