

Complex Numbers

TI-82

- The **TI-82** cannot do operations with complex numbers.

TI-83 and TI-84

- On the **TI-83** and **84**, there is a little script i above the decimal point.
- You may need to change MODE from Real to $a+bi$.

TI-85 and TI-86

- The **TI-85** and **TI-86** use a different notation.
- Rather than $a+bi$, they use (a,b) .
- For example, to enter $(4+i)+(5+i)$, type $(4,1)+(5,1)$.
- The calculator will give $(9,2)$, i.e. $9+2i$, as the answer.
