- 1. Convene and Welcome
- 2. Minutes from October 2021 approved. Glenna will reformat and submit them to the AP Executive committee for posting.
- 3. Still do not have representatives from Groups 1 and 6. Glenna will review membership in groups to consider if we can invite someone. Confirm if formal invitation comes from AP Executive committee.
- 4. Reviewed priorities for AY 21-22
  - 1. Demographics of staff turnover:
    - a. Just received data. After a quick glance, Justin offered to provide some analysis for December meeting.
  - 2. Determine what it looks like to walk the talk on diversity, inclusion & Equity
    - a. Audra will investigate how to generate focus groups
    - b. Audra will write up an invitation for the next AP newsletter.
  - 3. AP read for Winter '22 semester

- a. Glenna suggested that we avoid a heavy-hitting book on Anti-Racism/White Consciousness because there is an ongoing 6-week workshop on this, and participation is high. Perhaps we consider something that is autobiographical, or even fiction that will be more affordable and a somewhat lighter read. (Perhaps will have higher participation.)
- b. Justin recommended Trevor Noah's Born a Crime.
- c. Everyone is invited to contribute to a list of possible books on the Google Doc and will vote by email to announce in the next newsletter
- d. Glenna will add an agenda item for next meeting: how will we coordinate the book discussion(s)?
- 4. Support for hiring committee training beyond Inclusion Advocates
  - a. Waiting to hear back from Marla Wick on process

### Open questions:

How do we find out who is working on what? We don't want to be redundant or work for no purpose. We can cross over several committees across university groups.

#### Notes

Need to review the inaugural committee notes. There was some initial work on this. Also, invited the employee ombuds officer to join SJC as an ex-officio member. We haven't followed up on that since. Glenna to review the inaugural committee docs and share in December
