## Faculty Writing Retreats

These 5-day retreats are an opportunity for faculty and staff to make extraordinary progress on a long writing project --or several shorter ones. Each day begins and ends with a facilitated conversation about goals, progress, and challenges, but the majority of time is spent writing in a productive and supportive environment. ## SWS Faculty Workshops

The SWS program runs workshops for faculty regularly throughout the school year. These workshops provide support through current research on relevant topics related to the teaching of writing across the curriculum. Workshops may be offered in person or via Zoom.
