● 7 Campuses

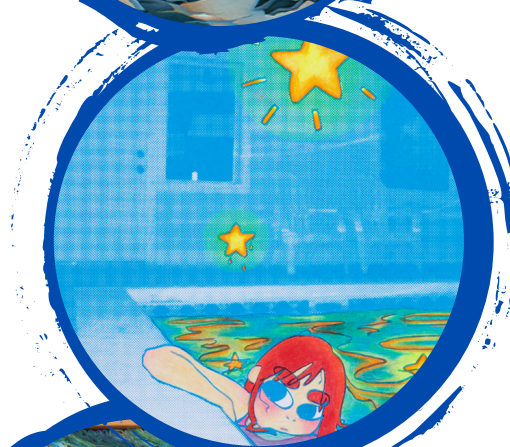
The GVSU Art Gallery collection is displayed on all seven campuses/regional centers in all 130 buildings.
