The CLAS Curriculum Committee (CCC) is responsible for the curricular review of all submitted New Course Proposals, Course Changes, New Programs and Certificates, Program Changes, and the facilitation of fast-track requests. The committee prides itself on being of assistance to all proposers in helping them facilitate their proposals smoothly through the review process. Additionally, when requested by the Administration, the CCC provides input relating to broader curricular issues. This committee provides a broad, cross-disciplinary curricular review and is proud of its tradition of 'diligence, integrity, good humor, and esprit de corps.'

The CCC maintains a close relationship with the CLAS Dean's Office to ensure that proposed curricular changes benefit the interests of the University, the departments of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and, most importantly, GVSU students.

At the time of this report (2014-2015), the committee has considered and reviewed 112 proposals. Most of these proposals continued on successfully through the curricular process. Of the total, 23 were for New Courses, 65 were Course Changes, and 23 were Program Change requests. There was also 1 New Program proposal. Additionally, we currently have 18 proposals pending that will be considered before the end of the semester, including a new Master's Program.
