What is a statistics poster?

A statistics poster visually tells a story through sets of data. Through charts, histograms, and tables of numerical summaries, viewers discover the meaning behind the data as they follow the poster's logical progression.

Why a statistics poster competition?

Constructing a statistics poster is a powerful way to learn how to analyze data and draw conclusions from data. As students tell stories through statistics posters, they exercise and further develop their quantitative and communication skills. Involvement in statistical activities is beneficial at all grade levels!

All K-12 students residing in Michigan are eligible to participate.
