

Bullying Prevention Grant Allowable and Unallowable Items



The Bullying Prevention Initiative Grant will fund:

- Create a peer-to-peer support program (START Project) that incorporates anti-bullying initiatives for children and/or youth with special health care needs (**Requirement**)
- Expand an existing program (START Project) to include anti-bullying initiatives for all students
- (Requirement)
- Salaries and wages
- Marketing and promotion for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Participation incentives for students for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Training for staff, students, and/or families for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Curriculum and programming for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Special events for program promotion for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Supplies for START Peer to Peer Support Programs
- Mileage and transportation costs connected to START Peer to Peer Support Programs

The Bullying Prevention Initiative Grant will <u>not</u> fund:

- Capital expenditures or endowment funds
- Building supplies, such as furniture
- Classroom/School supplies
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Before/After School Programs
- Unnamed miscellaneous items
- Building modifications, such as murals, painting, decorating, structural changes to buildings
- Break rooms, lounge rooms, meditation rooms, self-care rooms, quiet rooms, or any items related to similar spaces
- Sensory items or a sensory room
- Televisions, computers, noise canceling headphones, or other electronics or electronic accessories
