A RESOLUTION TO: Endorse the Quality Initiative Report-Improving the Quality of the General Education Program at GVSU

Recognizing, Grand Valley State University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) using the Open Pathways process for review/oversight by HLC, which is currently a 10-year cycle¹;

Whereas, this Quality Initiative takes place between years 5 and 9 of the cycle, this initiative in particular taking place 2013-2016²;

Whereas, the purpose of the 2013-2016 GVSU Quality Initiative was to launch a rigorous assessment of student learning in the General Education (GE) Program in order to continuously engage in quality improvement focused on student learning³;

Recognizing, that two senators, Vice President Jeremy Turnbull and Senator Carly Aller, have sat on the General Education Committee and worked with the chair of the General Education program on this report, and whose opinions are continuously sought on the committee⁴;

Let It Be Resolved, that the Grand Valley State University Student Senate recognizes the effort and endorses the Quality Initiative Report for Improving the Quality of the General Education Program.
