
# **Camera Movement**

Pan - Horizontal

Tilt - Vertical

Zoom - Digital

**Dolly** - Physical



# **How to Use a Camera**

## Safety

- Always use safety strap
- Keep free from dust, debris, and moisture
- Extreme temperature changes can damage camera
- Don't leave it unattended
- If it's not in a case, somebody should always have a hand on it

# **Lighting**

### **Color Temperature**

- Color temperature is a characteristic of visible light that has important applications in lighting.
- Color temperatures over 5,000K are called *cool colors* (bluish white), while lower color temperatures (2,700–3,000 K) are called *warm colors* (yellowish white through red).

#### Colour Temperatures in the Kelvin Scale


