- Statistics minors and other quantitative majors excel in the program, as do statistics majors. Biology pre-requisite courses aren't necessary.
- A Master's in Biostatistics prepares you for careers in non-health related and health related companies.
- An internship is built into the program giving our graduates an advantage over other programs. Internships within the program are plentiful. Some students in the program do more than one.
- Typically, 100% job placement by end of July for April graduates.
- Strong job outlook locally, nationally and internationally.
- You can do up to 12 graduate credits (to be counted towards the Master's) as an undergraduate without yet being officially in the program.
