POSITION: Visiting Faculty Member in Statistics

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must have a M.S. or Ph.D. in Statistics, Biostatistics, or related field. A commitment to teaching excellence is required. Candidates must have an interest in using technology in the undergraduate curriculum.

SALARY: Commensurate with qualifications.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Duties include teaching 4 three-hour statistics courses per semester. Resources may be available for professional development, consulting, and scholarship. Employment begins August 2018.
