#### **BLM IS NOT ANTI-POLICE**

 Understand the risks associated with the job.

 Seeking same treatment that is afforded to white counterparts.



#### **BLM IS NOT ANTI-LGBT**

- Affirms the lives of ALL people.
- Established queer individuals of color as leaders.
- Highlight the murders of Trans women of color.



#### BLM IS NOT BLIND TO BLACK ON BLACK VIOLENCE

- Majority of crime is interracial.
  - 93% Black on Black
  - 84% White on White
- Poverty Rates.
- Tactic of diversion.



#### **BLM IS NOT ANTI-WHITE**

- Not an Anti-White Proposition
- Black Lives Matter, Too!
- Looking to affirm the lives of black people and be treated with the same value as whites.
