Admission Information

The **Diagnostic Medical Sonography** program at GVSU is **competitive and requires completion of a secondary application** which is available online at www.gvsu.edu/rad. Applications are due February 1st. Applicants must complete the prerequisite courses along with all GVSU General Education requirements prior to the start of the program. Students may apply to the program **February 1** if they can demonstrate that this course work will be done by the time the program starts in August. There is no waiting lists.

Application Requirements:

- ✓ GVSU Application – must be admitted and eligible to begin taking classes the fall following application deadline
- ✓ Program Application & Supplemental Materials – found at www.gvsu.edu/rad > prospective students > program application
- ✓ Resume – to include a specific section listing health care experience & a 2-3 hour job shadow
- ✓ Statement of Professional Goals – why are you interested, what are your plans, what influenced your decision
- ✓ Volunteer or Work in Health Field – minimum 16 hours experience in a health field (due at time of application)
- ✓ Job Shadow – 2-3 hour job shadow with a practitioner in your field of application (due at time of application)
- ✓ Two recommendations – on form provided with program application
- ✓ Transcripts – Official copies of ALL non-GVSU transcripts sent with your program application or to the address below
- ✓ Prerequisite & General Education Course Worksheet
- ✓ Statement of Coursework Completion – describe how required courses will be completed PRIOR to start of the program

Admissions Considerations

- Academic grade point average from prerequisite courses (40%)
- Academic grade point average from previous two calendar years (10%)
- Interview and Writing Assessment completed on-site at the Cook DeVos Center for Health Sciences (30%)
- Completion of 16 hours of volunteer/work experience in a health field (5%)
- Recommendations (5%)
- Additional leadership considerations (10%)
