## **Essential Functions:**

- Perform minor and preventative maintenance on assigned grounds equipment.
- Operate equipment such as mowers, trucks tractors, payloader, and power/hand tools in a safe and effective manner.
- Work with and apply fertilizers to shrub, annual/perennial beds, and turfgrass areas.
- Maintain grounds including mowing, fertilizing, trimming, pruning, turf care, aerating, leaf removal, trenching, trash pick-up, and similar maintenance duties.
- Maintain shrubs, annual and perennial flowers and beds, ponds; including fertilizing, trimming, pruning, hand weeding, over the counter premixed chemical treatments, leaf removal and trash pick-up.
- Ability to accomplish duties from general instructions, and with minimal supervision. Be safety conscious, and follow all safety rules and standards.
- Provide quality customer service to faculty, staff, students and campus visitors.
- Commit to being assigned as an essential employee, meaning you may be required to work when others are excused.
- Enforce and support policies established by the Facilities Services leadership.
- Attend to Facilities Services related emergencies when necessary.
- Attend safety meetings and other related meetings.
- · Work with and lead the activities of student staff.
- Perform other related duties as required.

## **Required Qualifications:**

- Prior grounds keeping, landscaping, gardening, construction, horticulture, agronomy, soils, or turf maintenance experience.
- Knowledge of standard hand and power tools and equipment used in grounds maintenance activities.
- Knowledge of safety standards and precautions pertaining to the use of tools and equipment related to grounds maintenance.
- Satisfactory work performance and attendance records.
- Demonstrated ability to work with minimum supervision.
- Valid Driver's license with acceptable driving record.
- Must have or obtain CDL license, within 90 days of the start of employment.
- Demonstrated ability to operate standard grounds and snow removal equipment.
- Willingness to work off shifts, holidays and overtime as necessary

## **Physical Demands:**

- Ability to perform heavy manual labor, including bending, twisting, stooping and reaching as needed.
- Climb and use of ladders up to heights of 8 feet.
