Job Title: Grounds Maintenance Specialist

Essential Functions:

- Selects, prepares, and applies various chemical solutions as required to maintain grounds.
- Operates specialty equipment.
- Organizes the planting calendar; specifying when to plant, fertilize, and irrigate the various flowers, trees, shrubs and sod.
- Review future construction plans and make recommendations in relation to area of expertise.
- Determines the appropriate timing and quantities of grounds care chemical applications such as fertilizer, herbicides, and pesticides.
- Determines the trimming, pruning, and other maintenance care required for the trees and shrubs.
- Determines the selection and placement of flowers, trees and shrubs.
- Oversees the layout, marking, and/or pattern mowing of the athletic fields.
- Repairs and maintains irrigation lines in working order.
- Trains grounds keeping personnel and provides daily instruction.
- Performs duties similar in nature or equivalent to those required of a Groundskeeper, including but not limited to mowing, fertilizing, trimming, pruning, hand weeding, turf care, leaf removal, trenching, trash pick-up.
- Perform minor and preventative maintenance on assigned grounds equipment.
- Ability to accomplish duties from general instructions and with minimal supervision. Be safety conscious and follow all safety rules and standards.
- Ability to plan, implement, and perform grounds maintenance activities such as planting, fertilizing, landscaping, snow removal, pruning, irrigating, athletic field markings, etc. as demonstrated through related work experience.
- Provide quality customer service to faculty, staff, students and campus visitors.
- Commit to being assigned as an essential employee, meaning you may be required to work when others are excused.
- Enforce and support policies established by the Facilities Services leadership.
- Work with and lead the activities of student staff.
- Attend to Facilities Services related emergencies when necessary.
- Attend safety meetings and other related meetings.
- Perform other related duties as required.

Required Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Horticulture, Arboriculture, Agronomy, or related field or equivalent certification or experience (at least 5 years).
- Must be, or able to be, a certified commercial applicator of chemicals within one month of being assigned as a Grounds Maintenance Specialist.
- Valid driver's license with acceptable driving record.
- Must have or obtain a CDL license within 90 days of the start of employment.
- Ability to work with others and to provide work instructions.
- Maintain a satisfactory work performance and attendance record.
- Maintain any applicable certifications while employed at the university.
- Willingness to work off shifts, holidays and overtime as necessary.

Physical Demands:

Ability to lift items or materials a minimum of 50 lbs.

- Ability to perform heavy manual labor, including bending, twisting, stooping and reaching as needed.
- Climb and use ladders up to 8 ft.
- Ability to work outdoors and/or in unairconditioned buildings, at university events, as required.
- Perform work duties/responsibilities for extended periods of time (approximately 12 hours/day) even during inclement weather.
