Curriculum Notes

- ¹ The Physical Therapy program at GVSU is a Clinical Doctorate degree which requires the completion of a nationally accredited bachelor's degree <u>prior to the fall start</u> of the DPT program. *No specific major is required.* Graduate program information is available at www.gvsu.edu/pt.
- ² The Physical Therapy program requires one of the following: SOC 101 or SOC 105 or ANT 204.
- ³ Students may substitute PSY 300 which can also be used to fulfill one of the two required (SWS) courses.
- ⁴ Students may choose a minor or elective courses to fulfill open credits.
- ⁵ MTH 122 <u>or</u> MTH 123 <u>or</u> MTH 201 are prerequisites of the DPT program. At GVSU MTH122 & MTH 123 <u>or</u> MTH 201 are prerequisites to PHY 220.

Special Notes:

- This is a **suggested** curriculum guide that might not be applicable to every student.
- Courses that include 'GE' are required classes that are in the major AND fulfill a General Education requirement.
- Two Supplemental Writing Skills (SWS) courses are required; 1 in your major and 1 from another GVSU department.
- Students must have a **minimum of 120 credits** to graduate with **58 of the 120 credits** being from a senior level institution and the **final 30 of the 120 credits** completed at GVSU.
