Application Process for Health Information Management

The Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management (HIM) program at GVSU has a selective admission process which requires completion of a secondary application. Priority application deadline is **February 27th at 5:00 pm** Late applications from qualified applicants will be accepted until all seats in the program are filled.

Admission Criteria

- Admitted to GVSU: Complete the Undergraduate Application at <https://www.gvsu.edu/admissions/>
- Completed HIM program application
 - Available at <http://www.gvsu.edu/ahs/health-information-management-36.htm>
- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Prerequisite courses: "C" or better grade in BMS 250, BMS 251, and AHS 100
- Completion of 45 semester hours (*includes current enrollment*), to include prerequisite courses along with:
 - GVSU General Education: Foundations, and Cultures courses
 - It is suggested to have one (1) SWS course completed prior to start of HIM coursework
 - Issues coursework must be completed prior to the start of the practicum phase of the HIM program
- Official and updated copies of **ALL** non-GVSU transcripts sent directly to the GVSU Admissions Office
