

HOW TO NAVIGATE THE FAIR

REVIEW THE EMPLOYER LIST CAREFULLY

Note all organizations that capture your interest.

What are they recruiting for? Don't count out organizations that you haven't heard of, you never know where the best opportunities might be.

PLAN OUT THE ROUTE YOU WILL TAKE

Use the employer list on the following page to determine where they are located and who you'd like to speak with at each location.

PREPARE AN ENTRY STATEMENT

Be ready to introduce yourself and initiate a conversation with the recruiter.

TAKE TIME TO TALK

Think of this as a shortened interview. This is a chance to speak one on one with a potential employer, so avoid dropping off your resume and leaving. Take the time to speak with the representative and make a good impression.

SMILE, SHAKE HANDS FIRMLY, & LISTEN ATTENTIVELY

Your positive body language will send a message of interest and enthusiasm. Be patient if you have to wait, this will happen with some popular organizations.

FOLLOW UP SUGGESTIONS

REMEMBER TO OBTAIN LITERATURE & BUSINESS CARDS

These will be helpful when writing follow up or thank you letters.

FOLLOW UP WITH ORGANIZATIONS

Write a letter to the recruiters indicating your interest in their organization and thanking them for the time they spent with you at the fair.

ALWAYS DO RESEARCH

Always do research on the company so that you can impress the people that you meet with the company.

MAKE A NETWORKING PLAN

This plan could include calling or e-mailing key recruiters, sending letters, or scheduling interviews.

FOLLOW UP WITH CONTACT REGULARLY

Be courteous. Keep track of the all the contacts and make notes. This will help you remember people and be able to follow up with details.

BE PREPARED

If a follow-up interview is offered; dress professionally, bring a resume, and present yourself in a businesslike manner.
