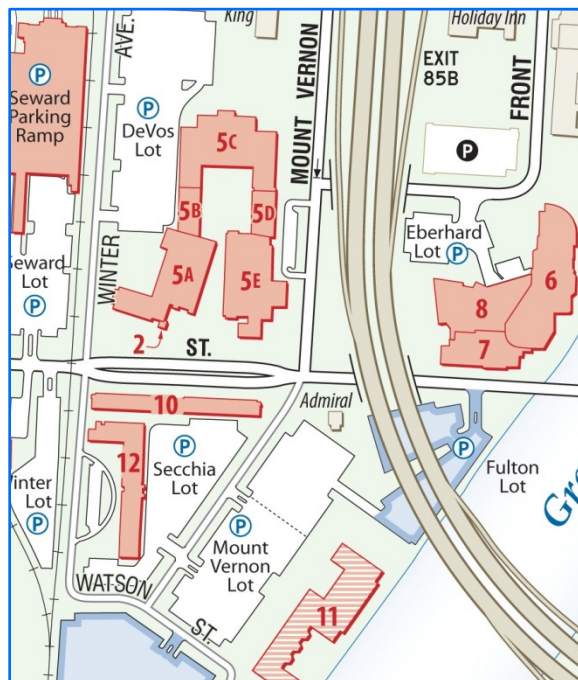
- Discuss the evidence regarding the effects of interprofessional education and practice on patient care quality and cost

ArtPrize:

In addition to the vibrancy of a West Michigan autumn, attendees of the Conference will also be able to experience the excitement of the Grand Rapids ArtPrize festival. Since 2009, ArtPrize has redefined how art can create community. ArtPrize allows artists to display their work and visitors to vote for their favorite piece of artwork.

For the 2012 festival year, ArtPrize drew 1,517 artists from 56 countries and 45 states. These 1,517 artists collaborated with 162 venues within the 3 square mile district of downtown Grand Rapids, and, in doing so, attracted over 322,000 spectators. With awards that totaled \$560,000, ArtPrize is the world's largest presenter of monetary prizes for artwork.

The official dates for ArtPrize 2013 are September 18th through October 6th. This unique, collaborative and creative spirit of downtown Grand Rapids will be available to the attendees of the 2013 IPE conference.
