- Healthcare experience is not required, but is strongly recommended.
- A GRE score submitted with application. No minimum score is required (current average of those admitted is Quantitative: 154, Verbal: 154, and Written: 4.3).

HOW TO PREPARE

- Complete your bachelor's degree in any area of study and all prerequisite courses with no grade of a C- or less.
- Excel in leadership, demonstrate experience dealing with public/ underserved, or perform volunteer service where there is significant enrichment to the community served.
- Discern that a career as a PA is what you really desire.
