#### **MTTC (State Required Tests)**

The Michigan Department of Education uses the *Newly-Redesigned* SAT as the Basic Skills Examination for Teacher Certification, and SAT scores are only valid if taken **AFTER** March 5, 2016. In order to meet the requirement for Teacher Certification, the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section must be passed with a score of 480 or higher, and Mathematics must be passed with a score of 530 or higher. In addition, the Content Area (#095- Visual Arts Education) test will be required prior to obtaining certification.
