2. COLLEGE OF EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (39CR)

MTTC (State Required Tests)

Passing score (minimum score of 220) on the MTTC Professional Readiness Examination (PRE) (#096) is required prior to admission to the College of Education. Passing scores on the Content Area (#095- Visual Arts Education) test will be required prior to obtaining certification. PREREQUISITES TO COLLEGE OF EDUCATION APPLICATION (9 CR)

A 3.00 GPA in the major, passing score on the MTTC Professional Readiness Exam (#096), and completion of EDF 315, EDI 337, and PSY 301 with a grade of C or better are required before admission to College of Education's Teacher Assisting semester.
