



## **Checklist: Art Education, K-12 Comprehensive Teacher Certification Program for BFA Major**

**Teachable emphasis areas are Ceramics, Graphic Design\*, Illustration\*, Jewelry/Metalsmithing, Painting, Printmaking, Sculpture, and Visual Studies.**

\*Graphic Design and Illustration require secondary admission.

### **2. COLLEGE OF EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (39CR)**

#### **MTTC (State Required Tests)**

The Michigan Department of Education uses the *Newly-Redesigned* SAT as the Basic Skills Examination for Teacher Certification, and SAT scores are only valid if taken **AFTER** March 5, 2016. In order to meet the requirement for Teacher Certification, the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section must be passed with a score of 480 or higher, and Mathematics must be passed with a score of 530 or higher. In addition, the Content Area (#095- Visual Arts Education) test will be required prior to obtaining certification. #### **PREREQUISITES TO COLLEGE OF EDUCATION APPLICATION (9 CR)**

A 3.00 GPA in major and a passing status and validity of SAT scores are required before admission to College of Education's Teacher Assisting. ED 315, ED 337, PSY 301 must be completed with grade of C or better **BEFORE** admission to Teacher Assisting.

#### **FLEX COURSES**

EDS 379 (Universal Design for Learning) – This course is taken before OR after admission to the College of Education. It must be completed before Student Teaching. Must be a grade B- or higher.

EDT 370 (Technology in Education) – This course is taken after admission to the College of Education. It must be completed before Student Teaching. Must be grade of B- or higher.
