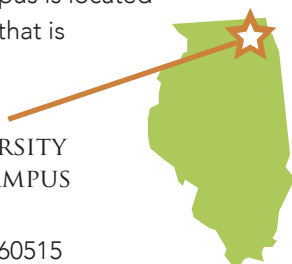
MIDWESTERN UNIVERSITY ONE HEALTH

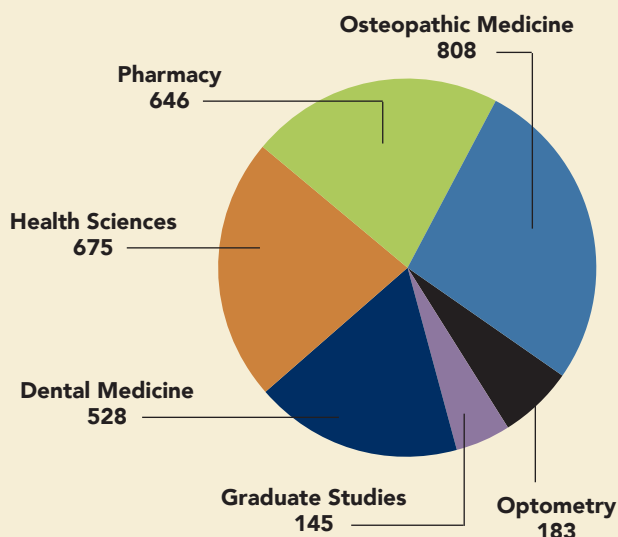

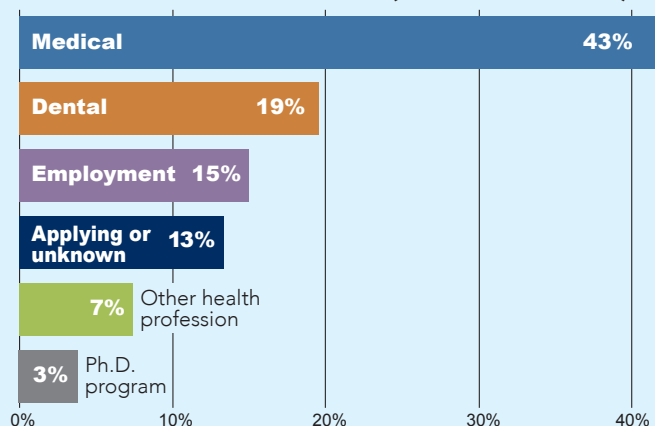

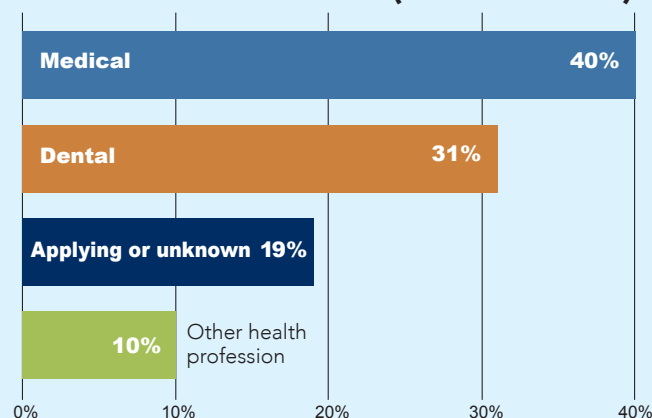
