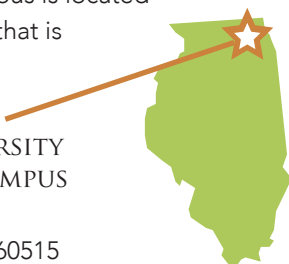
MIDWESTERN UNIVERSITY ONE HEALTH

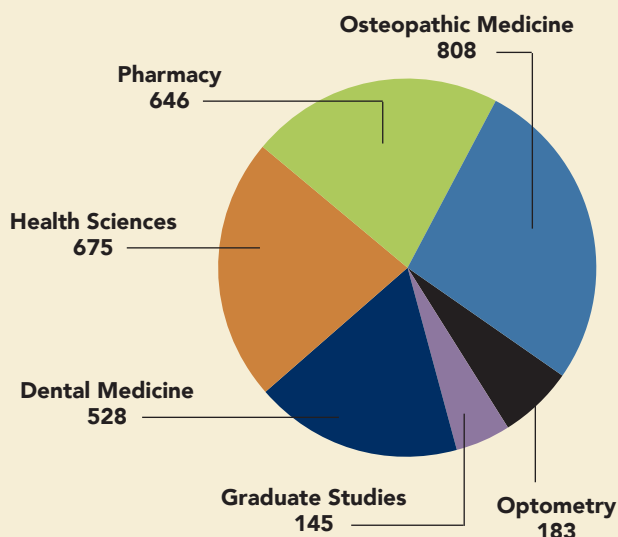

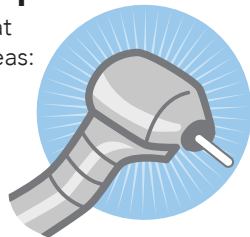
