2. COLLEGE OF EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS (39CR)

MTTC (State Required Tests)

The Michigan Department of Education uses the *Newly-Redesigned* SAT as the Basic Skills Examination for Teacher Certification, and SAT scores are only valid if taken **AFTER** March 5, 2016. In order to meet the requirement for Teacher Certification, the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section must be passed with a score of 480 or higher, and Mathematics must be passed with a score of 530 or higher. In addition, the Content Area (#095- Visual Arts Education) test will be required prior to obtaining certification. PREREQUISITES TO COLLEGE OF EDUCATION APPLICATION (9 CR)

A 3.00 GPA in major and a passing status and validity of SAT scores are required before admission to College of Education's Teacher Assisting. ED 315, ED 337, PSY 301 must be completed with grade of C or better **BEFORE** admission to Teacher Assisting.
