(COM-UHP) offers support by advising pre-med students on the medical school admissions process. Services are <u>free</u>, and involve advising, counseling, and <u>assisting pre-medical students towards being a competitive medical school applicant and becoming a physician.</u>

COM-UHP also offers the following for students entering the medical school application cycle:

- AMCAS Application complete review
- Personal Essay review & analysis (from drafts to final version)
- Mock interviews (only when active in the UIC Admissions cycle)
- One on One Advising Appointments

COM-UHP Advising involves general strategies how to become a competitive applicant, how to best prepare for the admissions process, the timelines when to best apply, and what pathways exist towards medical school.
