## Sample Schedule

\* Incoming Freshman Dance students take technique placement during the first week of classes. Students will take these courses multiple times, receiving up to 10 credits for each.

\*\* Dance Elective options include: DAN 231 Ballet Partnering, DAN 241/341/441 Ballet Technique, DAN 251/351/451 Modern Technique, DAN 262 Pointe, DAN 271 Men's Technique, DAN 275 Dance Company, DAN 281/ 381/481 Jazz Technique, DAN 380 Special Topics in Dance, DAN 392 Site-Specific Dance, DAN 393 Dance Conditioning, DAN 394 Dance on Camera, DAN 499 Independent Study. Students who have not been admitted into the Dance Program should contact the department for audition information.

## Degree: B.A.

### Bachelor of Arts

## Declaring a Dance Major:

In order to declare Dance as your major you have to be formally accepted into the Dance Program. In order to be accepted you must audition. If you have any questions about auditions please contact the Department of Music, Theatre, and Dance at 616-331-3484. If you have auditioned and been accepted please complete the following steps in order to declare your major.

1. Go to the Department of Music, Theatre, and Dance's website [www.gvsu.edu/mtd](http://www.gvsu.edu/mtd) and click on the current student tab and select student forms.
2. Scroll down to Major Declaration and click on the tab.
3. Print the form and fill out your personal information.
4. Sign and return the form to the Department of Music, Theatre, and Dance in 1300 Haas Center for Performing Arts.
