*Completion of a minor in Geology requires 26-27 credits.*

Complete all of the following:

- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 111 – Exploring the Earth (4 cr.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 112 – Earth History (4 cr.) (Prereq: a course in physical or general geology)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 175 – Research Tools for Geosciences (1 cr.)  
(Prereqs: GEO 111 and 112. GEO 112 may be taken concurrently)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 211 – Mineralogy (4 cr.) (Prereqs: GEO 111 and CHM 115)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 212 – Petrology (4 cr.) (Prereqs: GEO 112 and GEO 211 and CHM 115)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 311 – Structural Geology (4 cr.) (Prereqs: GEO 212 and MTH 123)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO 485 – Geology Seminar (1 cr.; taken over 2 semesters)  
(Prereq: Geology or Earth Science major or minor)
- \_\_\_\_\_ GEO Elective (300 level or 400 level) (3-4 cr.)

\*Geology theme/issue courses cannot count toward the geology minor
