¹ Students who self-place into WRT 120 should take this course in the fall semester and then take WRT 130 in the winter semester of their first year. Students who self-place into WRT 150 can take it in either semester during their first year. Students will not need to take WRT 150 if they have earned credit for the course through AP/Dual Enrollment. A grade of C or better is required in WRT 130 or 150 in order to satisfy the WRT requirement at GVSU.

Additioanl Considerations for Scheduling and Course Selection:

² Students who take MKT 300 instead of MKT 350 will need to take a course requiring STA 215 as a pre-requisite in place of MKT 352. STA 345 is recommended as a course that will cover this requirement and an Issues requirement.

³ Students must have a minimum of 120 credits to graduate with 58 of the 120 credits being from a senior level institution and the final 30 of the 120 credits completed at GVSU. Elective refers to any course that will help meet these requirements.

⁴ Students must complete two courses with an SWS attribute.

⁵MOV 102 provides a certification in First Aid/CPR that is required for SPM 390 and SPM 490. Students should take MOV 102 within two years of when they intend to take SPM 490. Students who already have a valid First Aid/CPR certification do not need to take MOV 102 and can submit their certifications to their SPM 390 and SPM 490 faculty in place of this course.

^{*}The block tuition rate is for 12-15 credits. You will pay additional tuition for any credits over 15. A total of 120 credits is required to graduate.

^{*}A major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required


