

Eugene and Lillian Pawl Pre-Medical Scholarship Application

Established by Dr. Lawrence E. Pawl in 2006, this scholarship honors his parents, Eugene and Lillian Pawl who did not graduate from college but provided that their son had this opportunity. This scholarship benefits Grand Valley State University pre-medical students who are the first in their families to attend college. The Scholarship is valued at \$1500 for the 2012-13 academic year.

Application Requirements

- Applicants must be the first child in his/her family to enroll in undergraduate higher education. The parents heading this family will have no earned undergraduate degree in higher education.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 55 credits hours and must be enrolled with full time status as an undergraduate pre-medical degree student expressing an interest in attending either an allopathic or osteopathic medical school upon graduation from GVSU.
- Applicants must be making satisfactory academic progress according to the norms established by the university and by the respective academic departments.
- Demonstration of financial need as defined by government programs is required. Applicants must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Candidates must have completed all prior undergraduate education at Grand Valley State University (Advance Placement and incidental transferable credit from summer courses excepted). This scholarship is not available to transfer students nor to candidates with previously earned undergraduate degrees.
