OR CPH 175 – Understanding Still Photography (Digital + Gen Ed)
 CPH 266 – History of Photography 1
 CPH 272 – Digital Photography 1 (Prereq: CPH 171 OR 175)

Complete any four other courses from the Photography curriculum, **other than** the capstone course. Go to the Photography page on the School of Communications website to see a list of courses. If a class you would like to take is not on the list, see your faculty advisor for the minor.
