AND / OR PHO 175 – Understanding Still Photography (Digital + Gen Ed)

(if taken both, one will count as an elective)

 PHO 266 – History of Photography 1 (Offered Fall Semester)

 PHO 272 – Digital Photography 1 (Prereq: CPH 171 or 175)

Complete any four other courses from the Photography curriculum, **other than** the capstone course. Choose four elective courses from the list below. If a class you would like to take is not on the list, see your faculty advisor for the minor.
