

INFORMATION LITERACY & LIBRARY RESEARCH SKILLS

Strong library research skills are crucial to producing excellent research projects. This workshop will help you better understand – and engage in – library research. We'll explore and practice identifying, evaluating, and using the types of resources you need to produce exceptional work. You may even find that these activities help you in other classrooms as well.

RESPONSIBLE & ETHICAL RESEARCH

This session will introduce students to the concepts of responsible conduct of research and the basic ethical principles of research, and provide examples of common research pitfalls to avoid.
