- 331: Survey of Spanish Literature OR 332: Survey of Spanish American Literature (prereq: 322 + 3 credits at 300 level)
- 400-level Literature (take one, from 410, 420, 430, 440, 450, 460, 470 or 480 when offered) (prereq: 330 AND either 331 or 332)
- 495: Capstone (prereq: one 3-credit class at 400 level, senior standing)
- 1 elective at SPA 300- or 400-level
- The OPI Requirement:** Students must demonstrate oral proficiency at the Advanced- low level or higher prior to Student Teaching in the College of Education.

** Students seeking Secondary Teacher Certification must also choose a teachable minor and complete the College of Education requirements.
