Boys Town

For more than 100 years, Boys Town has been saving children and healing families across America. As one of the country's largest privately funded organizations caring for at-risk youth, Boys Town is a leader in the care and treatment of boys and girls who desperately need love, compassion, and guidance. The village of Boys Town provides care and treatment to more than 500 boys and girls, typically ages 10-17. Located near Omaha, Nebraska, the residential campus is comprised of 66 Treatment Family Homes. Each home features a family-style treatment approach, in which a specially trained married couple lives in the home 24 hours a day, utilizing the Boys Town Teaching Model. These Family Teachers use behavioral principles to teach youth life and social skills, build appropriate relationships, and help youth develop self-discipline. Boys Town operates two schools in the village: Boys Town High School and Wegner Middle School. Both are fully accredited by the Nebraska Department of Education and the North Central Association and offer extracurricular activities and athletics to youth, to create a more normalized setting. The Boys Town National Research Hospital is located on campus and is accessible to youth for regular doctor and mental health visits.

Lighthouse

For mariners, a lighthouse often represents a beacon of hope when they have ventured off course. A lighthouse is also a critical guide when charting a careful return to port or departure to sea. The 20th Circuit, Juvenile Court Lighthouse Program is a secure residential treatment for girls, to offer hope in discovering a deliberate, viable, charted course for their futures. Located in the American Correctional Association accredited Ottawa County Juvenile Detention Center, Lighthouse is a short-term residential treatment program. The program is open to females ages 12 to 17 under court jurisdiction. The focus lies heavily on stabilization and therapeutic support; Lighthouse individualizes programming to meet the needs of the girl and her family for a successful and safe journey back into the community.

Safe Harbor Adolescent Recovery Program (SHARP)

SHARP, is a court-administered, co-ed, adolescent substance abuse treatment program offering all phases of treatment: stabilization, assessment, treatment and transition services. This is a collaborative approach with treatment providers, Charlevoix Public Schools and court licensed foster providers. This "least restrictive" style of in-patient services accessible through an Intensive Out-Patient arena enables a cost reduction by ½ as compared to the State approved rate for In-Patient programming.

Charlevoix County Probate/Family Court will coordinate all referrals and placements into our program. The per diem rate for this program is \$160.00.
